

RULES AND REGULATION FOR 'UNFAIR MEANS'

University of Mumbai Ordinance 5050.

WHAT IS UNFAIRMEANS ?

"Unfair means" includes one or more of the following acts or omissions on the part of students during the examination period.

- Possessing unfair means material & or copying there from.
- Transcribing any unauthorised material or any other use thereof.
- Intimidating or using obscene language or threatening or one of violence against invigilator or person on duty for the conduct of examination or manhandling him/her or leaving the examination hall without permission of the supervisor or causing disturbance in any manner in the examination proceedings..
- Communicating with other examinees or anyone else inside or outside the examination hall.
- Mutual / Mass copying.
- Smuggling-put, either blank or written, or smuggling in of answerbook as copying materials.
- Smuggling-in blank or written answerbook & forging signature of the Jr. Supervisor thereon.
- Interfering with or counterfeiting of university / college / Institution seal, or answer books or office stationery used in the examination.
- Insertion of currency notes in the answerbooks or attempting to bribe any of the person connected with conduct of examination.
- Impersonation at the University / College / Institution examination.
- Revealing identity in any form in the answer written or in any other part of the answerbook by the student at the University or College or Institution examination.
- Or any other similar act/s & / or omission/s which may be considered as unfair means by the competent authority.

PUNISHMENT

The competent authority concerned i.e. the board of examination in the cases of University examination the concerned Principal in the cases of college examination & the Head in the cases of examination held by the recognised Institution after into consideration the report committee shall pass such order as it deems fit including granting the student benefit of doubt, issuing warning or exonerating him/her from the charges & shall impose any one or more of the following punishments on the students found guilty of using unfair means.

- a) Annulment of performance of the students in null or in part in the examination he/she has appeared for.
- b) Debarring student from taking appearing for any examination of the University or college or Institution for a stipulated period not exceeding five years.
- c) Debarring student from taking admission for any course in the university or college or Institution for a stipulated time to him/her in that examination.
- d) Cancellation of the University or College or Institution Scholarships or awards or prize or medal etc. awarded to him/her in that examination.
- e) In addition to the above mentioned punishment competent authority may impose a fine on the student declared guilty. If student concerned fails to pay the fine within a stipulated period, the competent authority may impose on such a student additional punishment / penalty as it may deem fit.
- f) As far as possible the Quantum of Punishment should be as prescribed (category wise) in Appendix - A of University of Mumbai - Unfair means 0.5050.
- g) The student concerned be informed of the punishment finally imposed on him/her in writing by the competent authority or by officer authorized by it in his/her behalf, under intimation to the college / Institution he / she belongs to.

1. Rules, Discipline and Code of Conduct for Students :

1. Student must display his/her valid ID Card.
2. Student should not loiter in the corridor during lecture/ Practical time.
3. Student should have minimum 75% attendance.

9. Ragging is strictly Prohibited, Ragging is Criminal Offence.
10. Student must participate in college regular classes, functions, guest lectures, extra curricular activities Social cultural gathering.
11. Be sincere and greet honors to elders, teaching staff & non teaching staff.
12. Make habit to read the notices on notice board.
13. Violation of any rule-regulation in college will be punished by fines & disciplinary action as per the intensity of offence.
14. Student must abide the rule and regulations of management, college, University and Government Of Maharashtra.

2. Code of Conduct for Teachers :

All the faculty members are expected to display a good conduct so that the students consider their teachers as their role model. Following are the code of conduct for faculty members :

1. All faculty members must maintain high standards of punctuality, honesty and professional ethics.
2. Every faculty members shall discharge his/her duties efficiently & effectively as per the norms laid down by the UGC and University of Mumbai.
3. Every faculty members should report to the college at least 10 minutes before the commencement of college timing.
4. All faculty members must be enthusiastic in taking up the subjects allotted to them.
5. All faculty members should prepare a lesson/teaching plan, notes, academic file well in advance before commencement of the classes.
6. Every faculty members should be responsible to conduct regular classes and practical's and also take extra classes whenever necessary.
7. Every faculty members shall respect the right and dignity of the student in expressing his/her opinion.
8. Every faculty members shall deal impartially with students regardless of their religion, caste, economic, social and physical identity.
9. No faculty members shall act in any manner that violates the decorum or morality within the campus.
10. Every faculty members should work within the institutional policies and practices so as to satisfy the vision and mission of the institute.
11. All faculty members must refrain from any harassment or unlawful discrimination based on existing legislative norms relating to gender/sexuality/age/marital status.



3. Code of Conduct for Non-Teaching Staff :

1. Every staff members employed in the Institute shall discharge his/her duties efficiently and diligently as per the rules and regulations laid by the Competent Authority.
2. All staff members should display the highest possible standards of professional behavior.
3. All staff members should be punctual and discipline towards their work.
4. Every staff members shall maintain the appropriate levels of confidentiality with respect to student and staff records and other sensitive matters.
5. Every staff members should co-operate with students, colleagues & superiors.
6. All staff members should maintain the image of the college through standards of dress, general courtesy etc.
7. All the staff members should respect for the right and opinions of others.
8. Every staff members should follow all norms and job details assigned by the Management, Principal & HOD from time to time with full dedication.
9. All staff members must refrain from any form of harassment or unlawful discrimination based on existing legislative norms relating to gender/sexuality/age/marital status.

Violations of code of conduct by the Teaching & Non-teaching staff are subject to disciplinary action, Show Cause Notice, Memo, Enquiry Committee, or any other action as per the Component Authority.

4. LIBRARY RULES AND REGULATION

7. Book issue & return timing will be from morning 9:00am to 5:00 pm in evening .



8. After completion of exam, Students must return book within 1 week
9. On the day of result declaration ,student must have to clear library dues.
10. While issuing books student must carry ID Card in absence of ID Card ,Student should seek permission from principal.
11. By instruction of president or principal late fees should be minimized or else debarred.
12. College alumni students or else other people can pay Rs.500/as deposit and can issue 2books at a time .They can return book within 1 month .After 1 month late fees Rs.1/ will be charged per day .Fine can exceed up to the actual price of book. Excess amount more than book price should not be taken from students.
13. Outsiders have to pay Rs. 500/- as deposit per year. From new academic year ,again he/she has to pay Rs.500/ for continuation of membership .Deposited amount will not be refunded at any cost
14. Interested outsiders who have willingness in becoming member of library, must have to submit Aadhar card Xerox , 2 Photos & his/her last attempt qualification document. Before submission of application he/she has to seek permission from principal. After securing permission he/she can deposit the annual subscription amount.
15. After completion of Degree students should be returned library deposit amount within 1 month later after 1 month deposit amount should not be returned, rather it should be utilized for library development.
16. College Teaching & Non-Teaching staff can issue or return books as per their requirement . After completion of academic year books should be returned .In case if book is lost or damaged then actual amount of book should be paid or same book should be provided to library.
17. Without any discrimination any book (Text,Journal,reference) should be issued to students or teachers.
18. Books purchase order should be submitted by HOD's to principal sir at the starting of academic year.
19. Any subject book can be issued by any student or teacher.
20. For smooth functioning of library and for making it student friendly, Library committee can share their views to principal sir occasionally.
21. It is compulsory to carry ID card before occupying reading room.
22. It should be kept into mind that teachers & students are the core elements of library .Their interest must have to be secured.
23. Principal sir, librarian and all HOD's should be on the panel of library committee.
